


## Art Activity Magic Nuudle Colorful Sculptures





### Summary:

Residents use packing peanuts and water to create free-form sculptures.

### **Objectives:**

- Encourage creative expression
- Foster positive mood
- Encourage verbalization/reminiscing
- Promote pro-social interaction







### Supplies:

- Colorful packing peanuts (Magic Nuudles)
- Water
- Paper towels
- Plastic trays or table cloth (working surface)

### Room Set Up:

- Tables for residents to comfortably work
- Soft, instrumental music in the background

Music, TV & Film > Jukebox



# **Facilitating the Activity**

## Procedure

1. Personally welcome residents to the group by saying each person's name and shaking each person's hand.

#### Say:

"Welcome to our group! Today we are going to have fun with these colorful 'noodles'."

Show residents the colorful Nuudles.

*"If we apply a little water to the noodles, they stick together! We can get creative and make any kind of shape or shapes we want! Let's get started."* 

- 2. Pass out a handful of Nuudles to each resident. Invite them to touch and squeeze the Nuud-les.
- 3. Pass out a shallow pan or cup of water to each resident.
- 4. Model dipping one end of the Nuudle into the water and then attaching to another Nuudle (the water combines with the Nuudle enabling them to attach to each other).
- 5. Invite residents to begin. The experience is done when residents indicate they are finished.



## Processing

Invite residents to share their experience.

- »» Did they enjoy the activity?
- »» Were they surprised with their results?
- »» Would they like to do this again?

Thank residents for participating.

## Adaptations/Modificiations



Cognitive Impairment: Moderate to Severe

- Watch for possible ingestion of materials.
- Allow residents to explore dipping entire Nuudles into water, allowing the Nuudles to become saturated.
- Perhaps the residents will enjoy sorting by color or making patterns.
