Playing Card Bowtie

Materials:

2 playing cards Masking tape Red or black yarn Scissors



Directions:

Fold the cards length-wise accordion style.

Fold the cards in half, and then tape both folded cards together with masking tape.

Wrap the bowtie with red or black yarn around the masking tape. Leave out a little bit of the starting part of the yarn, so when you finish wrapping you can tie a double knot with the other end.

Playing Card Banner

Materials:

Playing cards Hole punch Red ribbon



Directions:

Cut a length of ribbon equal to the length of the banner you want to make.

Punch holes in the upper right and left corner of each card.

String the cards on the ribbon and hang the banner.

Card Doors

Materials:

Red or black paper Scissors Tape



Directions:

Select the number and suit of the card you want to make.

Cut the two numbers and the appropriate number of suit shapes to create the card.

Using two-sided tape, attach the numbers and suits to the door to resemble a playing card.

Playing Card Wreath

Materials:

Playing cards
Glue gun
Paper plate
Scissors
Ribbon (optional)



Directions:

Cut the center out of the paper plate and discard.

Use the hot glue gun to attach the playing cards to the outer edge of the plate as desired.

Attach ribbon and hang.

Playing Card Hair Clip

Materials:

Playing cards Scissors Glue gun Bobby pin



Directions:

Choose the playing card or cards you would like to use for your design.

Cut 7 circles approximately the size of a nickel. Select one circle to be the center and glue the remaining circles around the center to form the petals.

Attach the flower to the end of a bobby pin with hot glue. Let dry.
