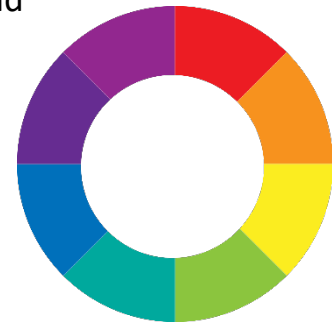


Grandparents Day Humor

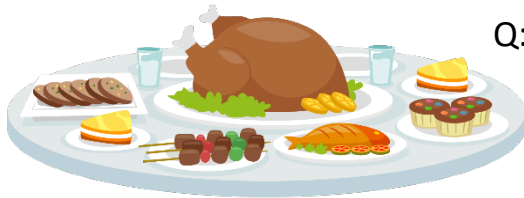
