

Super Bowl Crafts

Football Hand Warmers

Materials:

Brown felt
White fabric paint
Paintbrush
Rice
Thread
Sewing machine

**Directions:**

Cut two 6" football shapes. Paint laces and stripes on one side with white paint. Let dry. Put the two shapes together and sew around the outside edge leaving a small opening. Fill with rice. Finish by sewing up the hole. To use, heat in microwave for 45 seconds.

Football Door Hanger

Materials:

6 craft Sticks
Paint (brown, white, and team colors)
Paintbrush
Hot glue
Ribbon or string



Directions:

Glue craft sticks together, side by side. Paint a football with brown paint and use the white paint for the stripes and laces. Paint the background with team colors. Attach ribbon to the back for hanging

Turf Placemats**Materials:**

AstroTurf
White paint
Paintbrush
Scissors

**Directions:**

Cut the AstroTurf down to the size of rectangular placemats. Then use a thin paint brush and white craft paint to paint lines along the edge. Add yard numbers, etc.!

Fleece Scarf**Materials:**

3 colors of fleece
Scissors
Sewing machine

**Directions:**

Cut fleece into 6" wide strips. Stack one on top of the other. Sew down the center through three layers. Cut fringe to about ¼" on both sides of the seam.

Team Spirit Pompom Gloves

Materials:

Yarn in team colors
Gloves
Fork
Scissors
Needle
Thread



Directions:

Take 1 strand of each color and wrap around fork until you get the desired thickness. Cut a strand of yarn about 6" long and thread it through the middle slot of the fork. Tie the knot as tight as possible and then slide the whole thing off the fork. Slide the scissors through one side and repeat on the other side. Shape the pom-poms into nice round shapes. Make 10. Using needle and thread, attach the pom-poms to the fingertips of the gloves.

Football Pennant Banner

Materials:

Brown felt
White fabric paint
Paintbrush
Scissors
Sharpie
Green ribbon
Glue



Directions:

Draw or trace triangle shapes onto felt. Cut out the triangles and paint football laces down the middle of the pennant. Let dry for at least 4 hours. Cut the ribbon as long as you desire, then add a few inches to make loops for hanging. Position your pennants on the ribbon and glue in place.

Foam Finger

Materials:

Finger template
Glue
Craft foam



Direction:

Trace the template on 2 foam sheets. Cut out the finger pieces. Hot glue around the edges of the finger shape and press the two sides together. Use scraps to add verbiage to the finger.

Football Coasters

Materials:

Burlap
Paper
White acrylic paint
Paintbrush
Sewing machine



Directions:

Start by making a football -shaped template to use to cut out your burlap. Take a rectangle of paper that is about 5.5" x 4.5". Fold it in half and then in half again. Round the corners to make a football shape. Use the template you made to cut out the football shapes from your burlap. You will need 2 football shapes for each coaster. Stack 2 football shapes and sew them together around the edge with a ½" seam allowance. Trim the edges a little under ¼" from your seam. Paint on the football design with white acrylic.

Mason Jar Football

Materials:

Mason jar
Brown and white acrylic paint
Paint brush
Twine or raffia



Directions:

Paint entire Mason jar brown. Use white acrylic to add stripes and laces to the football jar. Tie twine or raffia around the rim of the jar.
